

Current situation

NT Airports is continuing to monitor the COVID-19 situation. Our priority remains the wellbeing and safety of our staff, contractors, visitors and travellers, and we are taking all the necessary precautions to ensure our people are protected.

Latest advice

There are 28 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the Northern Territory and 25 people have recovered. It has been three weeks since the last confirmed case.

On Thursday 30 April, the Northern Territory Government announced their Roadmap to the New Normal outlining the next steps for the Northern Territory, including reduced restrictions. NT Airports will be working through what this means over the coming days and continue to keep you informed.

While the situation is currently stable and some restrictions in the Territory are easing, it is important that we continue to follow the recommended advice and avoid becoming complacent.

Restrictions to communities

Restrictions on travel to Northern Territory remote communities are currently in place. Only essential travel, defined as functions that are necessary to keep the community operating, will be allowed.

Anyone travelling to communities for non-essential purposes will have to self-isolate for 14 days.
